

Florida Food Handler Card

Cost & Renewal Quick Reference

How much does it cost?

Florida law caps food handler training and testing at \$15. Most approved providers charge between \$7–\$25. SafePrep offers exam prep for just \$2.99 before you sit your official DBPR-approved exam.

How long is my card valid?

Your Florida food handler card is valid for 3 years from the date you pass your exam.

When do I need to renew?

Florida requires renewal every 3 years — you'll retake an approved training course and exam, the same process as your original certification.

Do I need to study first?

It's not required, but a short study guide helps you pass on the first try and avoid the cost of a retake.

What's on the exam?

Core food safety topics: time & temperature control, cross-contamination, cleaning & sanitizing, personal hygiene, and allergen awareness.
